What it Takes...

The Construction Inspector Apprenticeship is a new training tradition recently added to Operating Engineers Local Union No. 3's proud history of apprenticeship. This program trains individuals to enter the Testing and Inspection Industry with core skills obtained in Academic classes and On-the Job training.

Apprentices will earn while they learn by attending supplemental related training classes outside of their on the job training. These specialized training courses are required to gain the knowledge and skills necessary to complete quality inspections, perform job related duties and most importantly help you gain the confidence needed to pass your required exams for International Code Council Certifications as a special inspector.

Construction Inspection is not for everyone, but for some individuals it is an exciting and satisfying profession. The training classes are academically challenging and applicants must be willing to work and study diligently to improve themselves. The program requires 6000 hours of on the job training , successful completion of 5 training periods and will take about 5 years to complete.

To apply for this tuition free training opportunity in an exciting and satisfying profession, candidates must meet the following entry requirements:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- High School Diploma / GED
- Valid California Drivers License
- Resident of Northern California in Local 3's Jurisdiction
- *Attend a mandatory one hour informational orientation outlining the Construction Inspector educational program and the apprenticeship application process.
- Pass Entry level vocational assessment testing (scheduled after submitting your application)
